



Dear Houston Student,


I am pleased to welcome you to a new opportunity that may open your world to a future in aviation and aerospace.

Students will have the opportunity to:

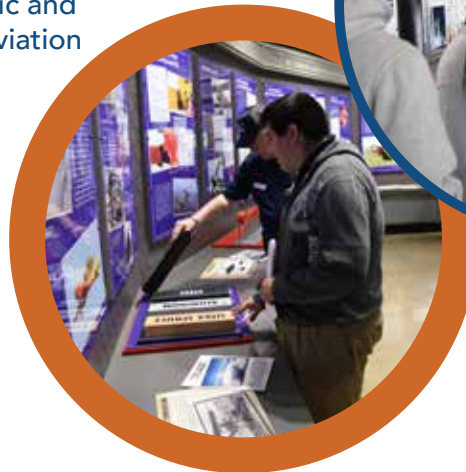
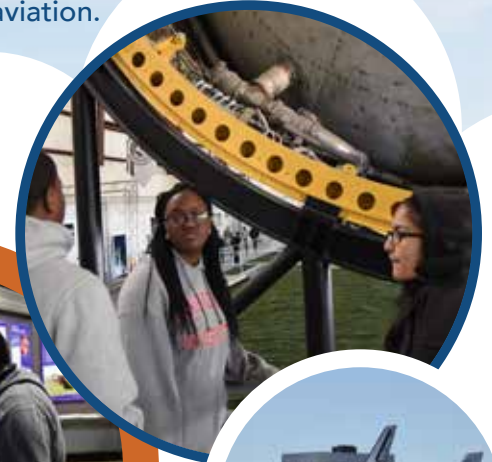
- Obtain paid Internships.
